Examinations fees are charged separately from tuition fees. All students who are to be entered for IGCSE/GCSE, AS and A-level external examinations will receive the invoice indicating the examinations they will be entered for. It is important for students and parents to check the invoice carefully to ensure the following:

- Personal information (date of birth, gender, spelling of names) is accurate as this information will appear on certificates. Please ensure student's name is as per passport. If the information on certificates is not correct this may cause issues when applying to universities or job applications. Please inform examinations officer of any errors.
- Check that all the subjects and units listed are correct and accounted for. If there are any errors or omissions inform examination officer immediately so corrections can be made and a new invoice can be issued.

If the invoice student has received is correct payment should be made either with the accounts department at the school's counter or via GEMS Connect → Fees & Payment → GCSE/A Level

Exams → Enter manually the total amount to be paid, as per the Invoice → Click Proceed → Select payment method → Complete the payment.

Please make sure you do that before the deadline stated on the entry form.

If payment hasn't been made by the deadline, a student's entries will be withdrawn.

IGCSE & A-Level Late/Very late fees

Late fees will be charged to all those who haven't completed the exam entry fee payment by the final entry deadline. From the late fee date, entry (unit or subject) fee is doubled. Entry fee tripled after the very late fee date. These are the examination boards' rules and the school, as an approved Centre, must adhere to them. It is, therefore, very important to make note of entry deadlines and ensure examination entry fees are paid on or before the deadline date.

BTEC – Late fees/Very Late Fees

Late fees will be charged to all those who haven't completed the entry fee payment by the final entry deadline. The late/very late fees will apply as follows:

- BTEC registrations made 61 - 90 days after learner enrolment - registration fee x 1.25.
- BTEC registrations made 91 - 120 days after learner enrolment - registration fee x 1.50.
- BTEC registrations made 121+ days after learner enrolment - registration fee x 2.

Enrolment day is 01/09/2023.

Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded for each entry withdrawn by the school before the date specified for each exam's series (refer to the dates listed above). Late, very late and amendment fees are not to be refunded. No refunds are made for those withdrawn after these dates (except on medical grounds, where partial refunds will be considered) or where students are simply absent from the exam. The examinations office should immediately be informed of any changes to examination entries. BTEC entry fees will be refunded if the request is made within 90 days from registration date and if student hasn't completed any units. After 90 days, no refunds will be issued.

This booklet will be updated prior to every examination season.

Here are some frequently asked questions about examination fees.

Why are examinations fees not included in tuition fees?

Examination fees differ per student based on their option choices. We therefore invoice students based on what examinations they are being entered for rather than a standard fee included in the tuition fees.

What are the examination fees for?

Examination boards charge for any examination's entries made to them. They charge per unit entered as outlined above. Included in the fees is an administration fee as well as an investment in the quality of examining teams and offered comprehensive support and training package for teachers.

Why is payment for examinations required so far in advance?

Deadlines for the payment of examinations fees are set in line with the examination boards' entry deadlines. If we do not submit the entries by the deadline, then parents will be charged the late fees. The examination boards double and eventually triple the fees. This is the examination boards' policy which is why we ask parents to make payment before the deadline dates to avoid paying these late fees.

BTEC registration fees will cover the full term of student’s registration, including:

- All the quality standard procedures that are required for the acquisition of a student’s qualification. This will include the bi-annual Standard Verifiers visit - the Pearson Educational representative who will visit the school to moderate students’ work
- The issuing of the final certification

Students cannot receive more than one qualification per registration and will be required to pay for each BTEC course they are studying.
