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Important information

- Parents will receive a Google link/form via e-mail to register for courses on Friday, 9th February 2024. The deadline for completing the Google form is Friday, 8th March 2024 (*only applies to current GFS students*). When a subject is full, it will be removed from the option choices.
- International GCSE/GCSE and BTEC subjects will be taught over a two-year period, in Years 10 and 11
- All students will take Mathematics (foundation or higher), English Language or English as a Second Language, English Literature, Physical Activity and Wellbeing, Moral, Social and Cultural Studies as compulsory subjects. Muslim students will take Islamic Studies and non-Muslim students will take Prep as compulsory subjects. Please note that core Physical Activity and Wellbeing, Islamic Studies, Prep and Moral, Social and Cultural Studies **are not International GCSE examined subjects** at GFS Non-Arab students are only required to take Ministry of Education (MoE) Arabic in Year 10
- International GCSE Arabic is not a mandatory course for Arab or non-Arab students at GFS
- Students must choose one of the three GFS Science pathways:
 - o Triple Science: students will obtain three science International GCSEs through this pathway
 - Single Science(s): students may choose one or two of the single sciences (e.g. Biology or Biology and Chemistry)
 - o BTEC Applied Science: If selecting this option, another science is not required (*note: please familiarise yourself with the requirements for equivalency*)
- Students **cannot** combine the following options:
 - Art and Design and Design and Technology Graphics
 BTEC Engineering and Design and Technology Resistant Materials
 Food Technology and BTEC
 Hospitality
