

Well-being:

This half term we will be reflecting on 'what makes us feel better?' so that we can identify our feelings and practice self-regulation strategies to manage our emotions. We will also look at our rights and responsibilities towards our friends and family and think about 'how to look after the people around us'. We will begin to learn about caring for our world and preserving environment.

Communication and Language:

We will practice retelling stories with an enhanced knowledge of stories and advanced vocabulary using our story maps. In our play we will introduce storylines and narratives influenced by our own personal experiences using a wide breadth of leant vocabulary. We will begin to innovate familiar stories and make up our own stories with beginning, middle and end. We will also begin to respond to how and why questions in the context of familiar stories.

Physical Development:

This half term we are working on our control and coordination with smaller tools, as well as being able to independently open and close a variety of containers. For gross motor skills, we are strengthening our core muscles to be able to sit on a chair or the floor and be able to follow instructions. In PE we will be learning to use a racket and focus on following the rules of the

We will continue to develop our creative skills by using a range of materials and media such as collage, pastel drawings and junk modeling. We will be focusing on creating art through collaboration using various construction materials.

Mathematics:


This half term, we will learn about odd and even numbers up to 10 and create repeated patterns such as AB, ABB, and ABBC. They will practice building and continuing number patterns beyond 10. In addition, they will explore basic addition and subtraction, using objects and visual models to understand how numbers combine and decrease. These activities will help strengthen their number sense, pattern recognition, and foundational math skills.

Understanding the World:

This term, we will explore how shadows are formed using everyday language. We will investigate how the sun creates shadows and what a shadow is, using torches to demonstrate. We will make observations about how light travels and experiment with translucent, opaque, and transparent materials.


