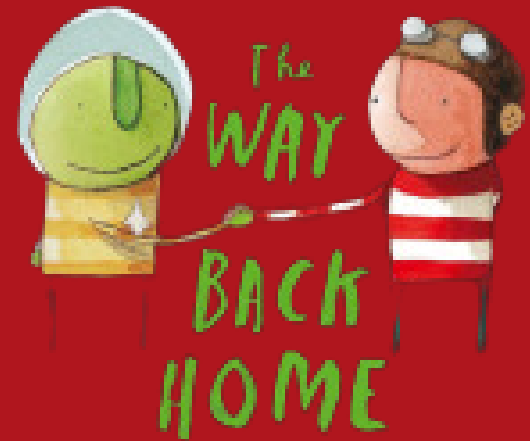

As writers, we will:

- Evaluate our own work, enabling us to make the needed edits to improve.



As readers, we will:

- Segment and blend sounds together to be able to read words.
- Be introduced to a range of fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Answer simple comprehension questions by deducting and inferring information from a text.



As mathematicians, we will:

- Solve addition and subtraction word problems.
- Count in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Compare length and height.
- Measure objects using standard and non-standard units of measurement.
- Compare weight and capacity.
- Measure weight using standard units of measurement.



As scientists we will :
